BOOK DONATION GUIDELINES

The Friends' Book Sale raises over \$20,000 each year for the Library. From September until the sale in April, we depend on a steady flow of donated books and media items. Crucial to a successful sale is that our inventory be "saleable."

What we need (and what raises money):

- Reasonably current fiction and non-fiction books as well as CDs and DVDs
- Classic literature in good condition
- Art, cooking, gardening and children's books usually sell well.
- Rare or unusual books for the Silent Auction

What we do not need (and what costs time and money for disposal):

- Books in bad condition (moldy, dirty)
- Textbooks, class notes, outdated academic and reference books (including encyclopedias)
- Magazines, brochures
- Readers' Digest Condensed Books; travel guides more than 5 years old
- Media: no VHS tapes or phonograph records

A good rule of thumb is to donate items you, your friends or neighbors might buy. We are unable to pick up donations. Books may be brought to the Library during regular hours, in bags or boxes if possible.
